

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION

To the Honorable Pat McKinley: Pursuant to Section 11020 of the California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of the City of Fullerton, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of Council Member in the City of Fullerton, California, and to demand election of a successor in that office.

The grounds for the recall are as follows:

Former Fullerton Police Chief McKinley was elected to the Fullerton city council with the endorsement of the Fullerton Police Officer's Association and has long supported policy and contracts which placed the special interests of the police unions and staff over the interests and safety of the community. His lack of leadership has helped create a culture of corruption in the Fullerton Police Department, culminating in the killing of an unarmed, mentally ill homeless man, Kelly Thomas. Currently, the City of Fullerton is the object of world wide ridicule.

McKinley actively opposed the rights of Fullerton citizens in claiming that the decision to release a publicly owned video of the Kelly Thomas beating should be left in the hands of the authorities.

McKinley has supported the wasteful Fullerton Redevelopment Agency which has reduced much needed revenues to the General Fund including police, fire, schools and infrastructure maintenance. Redevelopment in Fullerton has led to the enrichment of individual donor/developers who exploit Fullerton taxpayers.


California Elections Code Section 11023

(a) Within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, the officer sought to be recalled may file with the elections official, or in the case of a state officer, the Secretary of State, an answer, in not more than 200 words, to the statement of the proponents.

(b) If an answer is filed, the officer shall, within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, also serve a copy of it, by personal delivery or by certified mail, on one of the proponents named in the notice of intention.

(c) The answer shall be signed and shall be accompanied by the printed name and business or residence address of the officer sought to be recalled.
