

**PETITION FOR RECALL**

TO THE HONORABLE City Council of the City of Fullerton,

Pursuant to the California Constitution and California election laws, we the undersigned registered and qualified electors of the City of Fullerton, of the County of Orange, California, respectfully state that we seek the recall and removal of Pat McKinley, holding the office of City Council Member, in the City of Fullerton, CA.

We demand an election of a successor to that office.

The following Notice of Intention to Circulate Recall Petition was served on August 8, 2011 to Pat McKinley:

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION**

To the Honorable Pat McKinley: Pursuant to Section 11020 of the California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of the City of Fullerton, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of Council Member in the City of Fullerton, California, and to demand election of a successor in that office.

**The grounds for the recall are as follows:**

Former Fullerton Police Chief McKinley was elected to the Fullerton city council with the endorsement of the Fullerton Police Officer's Association and has long supported policy and contracts which placed the special interests of the police unions and staff over the interests and safety of the community. His lack of leadership has helped create a culture of corruption in the Fullerton Police Department, culminating in the killing of an unarmed, mentally ill homeless man, Kelly Thomas. Currently, the City of Fullerton is the object of world wide ridicule.

McKinley actively opposed the rights of Fullerton citizens in claiming that the decision to release a publicly owned video of the Kelly Thomas beating should be left in the hands of the authorities.

McKinley has supported the wasteful Fullerton Redevelopment Agency which has reduced much needed revenues to the General Fund including police, fire, schools and infrastructure maintenance. Redevelopment in Fullerton has led to the enrichment of individual donor/developers who exploit Fullerton taxpayers.
